CALL TO ORDER & WELCOME:

CAO Haney led the discussion on the School Resource Officer Contract for FY22-23. The proposed agreement from the Kenton County Board of Education was increased from \$60,000 to \$67,000 for this fiscal year. The Commission also discussed requiring Kenton County Board of Education to pay 75% for FY22-23 and 100% for the future years following FY22-23.

Discussion took place about placing a three (3) minute limit for each person speaking at a Commission Meeting. Commissioner Merritt also expressed a desire for the public to be allowed to speak at Caucus Meetings.

CAO Brian Haney discussed scheduling a first reading Ordinance 380 of the Budget Amendment to be on Wednesday, June 29th.

Commissioner Kreimborg left the meeting at 11:38am.

The Commission discussed Republic Services versus Rumpke Services for trash and recycling services.

The Commission discussed the location of the amphitheater.

CAO recommended that the Commission promote James Mills to the Police Chief position. He asked to be given permission to have a Municipal Order created for July's meeting.

There being no further business to discuss, Mayor Bell called for a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Murray so moved, with a second from Commissioner Braden to adjourn the

meeting. The motion passed with the unanimous approval of the Commission, the time being 11:52 a.m.
