



NEWS FROM THE MILL...

The city commission approved the construction bids for the 2022 street Program.

The 2022 street paving/repair program will include the following streets: Valley Square Drive, Heatherstone Court, Stoneledge Court, Sunny Acres Lane, Roselawn Drive, Millstone Court, Homestead Drive, Eureka Drive, Beech Drive, and Honeysuckle Drive. In addition, work will be completed on the Keavy Drive stabilization which includes construction of a pier wall and reconstruction of the road over the dam.

The total 2022 construction cost will be \$759,059 which will be the largest amount ever committed to repaving and repairing streets. The construction contract was awarded to Michels construction. The work will begin in the spring.

The Taylor Mill Sidewalk Phase 3 project is proceeding. The updated plans were submitted to KYTC and

approved on January 10, 2022. The final design scope of the project was cost estimated and additional SNK funds was requested by the city. The city was awarded an additional \$84,642 SNK funds for right-a way acquisition. This additional money brings the total SNK funds allotted for the project to over \$1,328,750, 20% of which is the responsibility of the City. The plans to upgrade Pride Park took a step in the right



direction when the ARPA grant dollars allotted to Taylor Mil were given more flexibility on how to spend the federal dollars. The city received approximately 1.7 million federal dollars during the pandemic to assist in replacing lost revenue that occurred.
