## Public Works Department Updates

The cold weather has arrived, and with the threat of snow or ice at any time, you can count on the City Public Works Department to be ready for any inclement weather headed to the area. Marc Roden and his crew have been hard at work getting our equipment ready, and the city will continue to have the best snow removal in Kenton County. Watch our website for announcements of Snow Emergencies and please be considerate to remove your vehicle from the roadway to allow our plows access to some of our more narrow streets.

## Road Construction Updates

The city received notice from KYTC that paving will begin on Taylor Mill Road/KY 3716 this Spring. The scope of work will also include Wayman Branch Road, which is not a part of KY 3716. The state has been working on cutting new culvert pipes across Wayman in preparation for the Spring paving.



## Pride Park Updates

Unfortunately, vandalism continues to be a problem in Pride Park. The shelter restrooms have been vandalized again, with the sinks torn from the wall. The Park restrooms have been closed for the winter. These acts must stop, and it's up to all of us to watch and report any actions of vandalism. These repeated acts of vandalism are costly and unacceptable. Fortunately, we have installed cameras that will help bring the vandals to justice.

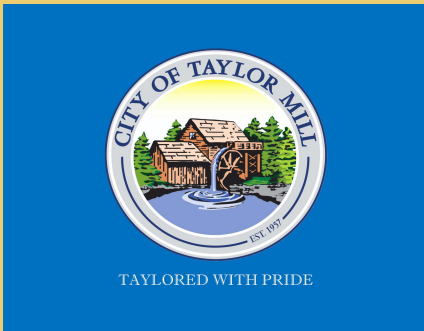


## Congratulations, Scott High School Cross Country Team

## 2023 City Street Repair

The commission has approved the 2023 City Street Repair Plan. The following streets will be paved beginning in the Spring of 2023: Forest View Lane, Wilson Road, Hogan Street, and Cleveland Avenue. The city also plans to complete the Parkview Drive concrete section, which we began in 2022. Thanks to Senator Chris McDaniel for helping us to secure funding to repair Wolf Road in 2023. The Kenton County Engineering Department and KYTC will oversee the road construction. The road will be paved from Decoursey Pike to Taylor Mill Road.
