

ORDINANCE NO. 375 (02-09-22)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TAYLOR MILL, KENTON COUNTY KENTUCKY AMENDING CODE SECTION 32.21 OF THE TAYLOR MILL CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ADDING A REGULARLY SCHEDULED CAUCUS MEETING

WHEREAS, Section 32.21 of the Taylor Mill Code of Ordinances states the location and dates for Taylor Mill Commission meetings;

WHEREAS, the Taylor Mill Commission wishes to add a regularly scheduled Caucus meeting;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.0 Creation of Caucus Meetings

(A) Regular meetings of the City Commission shall be conducted at the Taylor Mill City Building, 5225 Taylor Mill Road, Taylor Mill, Kentucky, at 7:00 p.m., prevailing time, on the second Wednesday of each calendar month, unless that day is a legal holiday.

(B) Caucus meetings of the City Commission shall be conducted at the Taylor Mill City Building, 5225 Taylor Mill Road, Taylor Mill, Kentucky, at 10:00 a.m., prevailing time, on the fourth Wednesday of each calendar month, unless that day is a legal holiday. There shall be no formal action taken at a Caucus meeting.

~~(B)~~ (C) Special meetings may be called by the Mayor or a majority of the City Commissioners. In the call, the Mayor or City Commissioners shall designate the purpose, time, and place of the special meeting with sufficient notice for the attendance of Commission members and for compliance with KRS Chapter 61.

~~(C)~~ (D) At a special meeting no business may be considered other than that set forth in the designation of purpose.

~~(D)~~ (E) The minutes of every meeting shall be signed by the person responsible for maintaining city records as provided under § 31.36 and by the officer presiding at the meeting.

Section 2.0 Severability

The provisions of this Municipal Order are severable, and the invalidity of any provision of this municipal order shall not affect the validity of any other provision thereof, and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

Section 3.0 Repeal of Conflicting Provisions


All Municipal Orders or parts of Municipal Orders in conflict with the provisions of this Municipal Order are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4.0 Effective Date

This Municipal Order shall be effective as soon as possible according to law.
