

ORDINANCE NO. 307 (08-12-2015)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TAYLOR MILL, IN KENTON COUNTY KENTUCKY, REPEALING ORDINANCE 3 (5-10-90) THAT ESTABLISHED A REQUIREMENT FOR A LICENSE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE IN THE CITY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TAYLOR MILL, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.0 – Repeal of Ordinance 3 (5-10-90)

Ordinance 3 (5-10-90) enacted on May 10, 1990 and relating to licenses to operate a motor vehicle in the City is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2.0 - Conflicting Ordinances Repealed:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3.0 - Effective Date:

This ordinance shall be effective as soon as possible according to law.

Section 4.0 - Publication:

This ordinance shall be published in summary pursuant to K.R.S. 83A.060 (9).


