

ORDINANCE NO. 358 (04-08-2020)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TAYLOR MILL IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, NAMING A PORTION OF KENTUCKY HIGHWAY NUMBER 16 IN THE CITY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TAYLOR MILL IN KENTON COUNTY KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.0 – Street Name**

That portion of Kentucky Highway number 16 in the City between the intersection thereof with Grand Avenue on the north and the common boundary of the cities of Covington and Taylor Mill on the south is hereby named Pride Parkway.

**Section 2.0 – Conflicting Ordinances Repealed**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 3.0 – Effective Date**

This ordinance shall be effective as soon as possible according to law.

**Section 4.0 - Publication**

This ordinance shall be published in summary pursuant to K.R.S. 83A.060 (9).
