

ORDINANCE NO. 310 (11-19-2015)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TAYLOR MILL, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING TAYLOR MILL ORDINANCE NO. 303 (11-28-14) BY INCREASING THE RATE OF THE ANNUAL WASTE COLLECTION ASSESSMENT LEVIED THEREBY TO ONE HUNDRED FORTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$145.00) DOLLARS PER YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TAYLOR MILL, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.0 – Amendment

Section II of Taylor Mill Ordinance No. 303 (11-28-14) is hereby again amended to read as follows, with the words and figures being added indicated by a single solid line underneath them; and the words and figures being deleted indicated by a broken line through them as required by K.R.S. 83A.060 (3):

SECTION II

The rate of said assessment shall be One Hundred and ~~Thirty~~ (\$130.00) Forty Five (\$145.00) Dollars per year for each residential unit within the City of Taylor Mill.

Section 2.0 – Provisions Severable

The provisions of this ordinance are severable; and the invalidity of any provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provision thereof; and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

Section 3.0 – Conflicting Ordinances Repealed

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4.0 – Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective as soon as possible according to law.

Section 5.0 - Publication

This ordinance shall be published in summary pursuant to K.R.S. 83A.060 (9).


