

ORDINANCE NO. 354 (03-11-2020)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TAYLOR MILL IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, IMPOSING HANDLING FEES ON IMPOUNDED MOTOR VEHICLES

WHEREAS, K.R.S. 82.625 authorizes local governments to impound motor vehicles for violations of statutes and ordinances and for any other lawful reason; and to impose handling charges upon such impounded motor vehicles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TAYLOR MILL IN KENTON COUNTY KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.0 – Imposition of Handling Charges

Pursuant to the authority of K.R.S. 82.625, a handling charge of Fifty Dollars (\$50) is hereby imposed upon each motor vehicle impounded by or on behalf of the City of Taylor Mill; and the City shall have a lien upon such impounded motor vehicle to secure the payment of such charge; and the release of such motor vehicle from impoundment is hereby conditioned upon the payment of such charge to the City.

Section 2.0 – Conflicting Ordinances Repealed

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, including, without limitation, ordinances 2-3-83 and 1-3-84 and 48 (11-11-92), are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3.0 – Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective as soon as possible according to law.

Section 4.0 - Publication

This ordinance shall be published in summary pursuant to K.R.S. 83A.060.


